Mission Strategy

We, the Session, Committee and members believe that it is the responsibility of our church to be involved in mission. Immediately before His ascension, Jesus said:-

"You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8)

We consider that there are 4 interrelated elements to mission:-

- Prayer We firmly believe that we need to seek God's guidance in all aspects of missionary endeavours and pray consistently and regularly for the work of mission

- Education It is our aim to provide members with adequate and relevant information to allow them to pray for specific missionary projects and provide support.

- Resources As a church we consider it is our responsibility to support the work of mission, both in terms of finances and personnel.

- Participation While we have an ongoing commitment to supporting the United Appeal of the Presbyterian Church in Ireland we will endeavour to identify ways in which our members can become involved in specific projects.
